

Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning

By CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT, the government of The University of Mississippi and of the other institutions of higher learning of the State of Mississippi is vested in a Board of Trustees appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The 12 members of this board are appointed to terms of 12 years, in groups of four each four years, of whom one is appointed from each Congressional District as constituted in 1944, one from each of the three Supreme Court Districts, and two from the state-at-large. There are no ex officio members. The Board of Trustees selects one of its members as president of the board and appoints the chancellor as executive head of the University. The board maintains offices at 3825 Ridgewood Road, Jackson, MS 39205.
